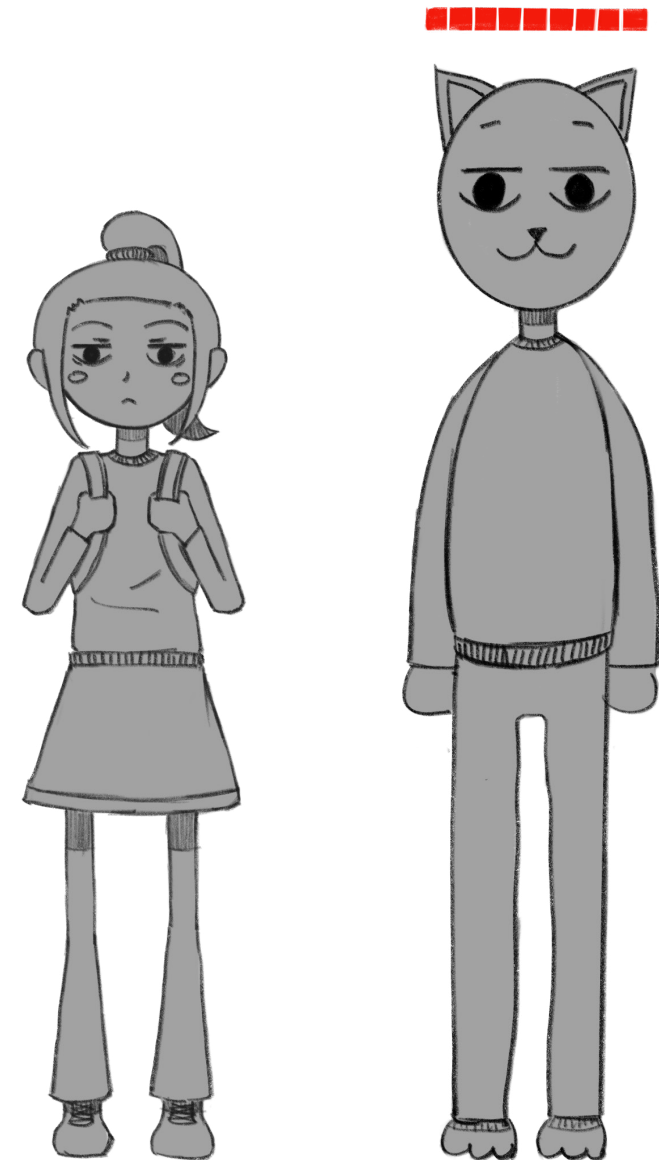


• Breif

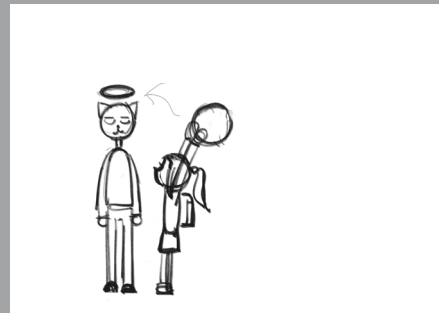
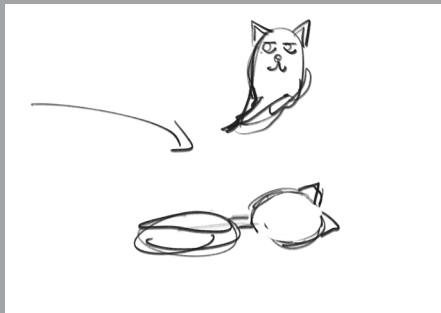
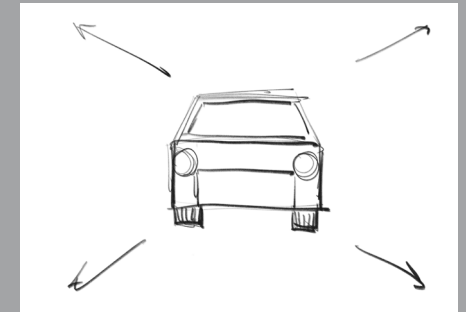
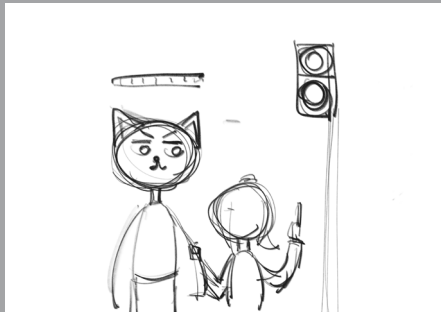
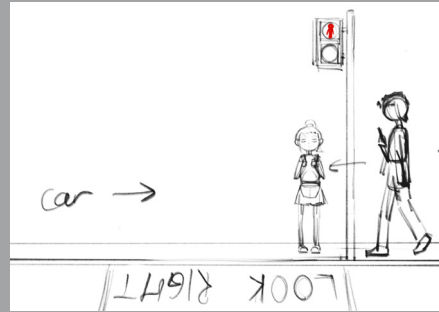
